The Penn Genomics Institute (PGI) announces interdisciplinary research program for Genome Sciences. The goal of the program is to provide undergraduate students with opportunities for training and research in genome sciences, including genomics, computational biology, genomics-related engineering, and systems modeling. The selected students will work with scientists associated with the PGI and receive interdisciplinary research training during the months of June and July. A stipend of \$2,000 per month will be provided. A subset of students will be encouraged to conduct year long guided research during the academic year and will be provided with research resource support.

**Eligibility:** Freshman, Sophomore and Junior students matriculating full time at Penn

2. A one page statement detailing why you are interested in this research program
3. Synopsis of coursework, and GPA
